

## Book Talk Jesús Salvador Treviño presents Return to Arroyo Grande

Join us for a presentation by author and filmmaker Jesús Salvador Treviño of his latest book, *Return to Arroyo Grande* (Arte Público Press, 2015), and a discussion of his diverse media career. CSRC director Chon A. Noriega will moderate the discussion. Books will be available for purchase at the event.

Treviño is considered a powerful storyteller in Chicano literature. Following characters introduced in his debut title, *The Fabulous Sinkhole and Other Stories*, Treviño's latest collection of short stories focuses on leaving home to pursue one's dreams and the importance of community.

**JESÚS SALVADOR TREVIÑO** is an award-winning filmmaker known for documentaries and feature films about the Chicano experience. He is the author of *The Fabulous Sinkhole and Other Stories* (Arte Público Press, 1995), *The Skyscraper that Flew* (Arte Público Press, 2005), and the critically acclaimed memoir, *Eyewitness: A Filmmaker's Memoir of the Chicano Movement* (Arte Público Press, 2001).
